JOB DESCRIPTION

- Lead and coordinate the activities foreseen for the Pilot Project, through the organization and management of local staff, establish positive relations at institutional level on the territories (municipalities), organize interaction among international and local experts, involve local communities in the project activities, as main beneficiaries.
- Organize local groups of stakeholders (fishers and relevant co-operatives; local administrations, universities) for the pro-active implementation of project activities, training courses, set-up and re-activation of the fishery supply chain and related services, refurbishment and management of the selected storage and refrigeration facility.
- Ensure to the beneficiaries of the Pilot Project, Business Planning support and Networking with the correspondent EU stakeholders, as drivers for the development of local supply chain and integration with their Italian and Tunisian partners.
- Draft substantive reports, organize and facilitate conferences, including identification of speakers, preparation of background documents, logistics, executive reports, follow-up.
- Co-operate and communicate with the REBUILD project management and the involved institutions in Italy, in Libya and Tunisia, with the European Commission, for the activation of the necessary operative integrations and possible synergies.
- Plan and monitor the activities, also through periodical budgeting and reporting, with the capability to manage and solve eventual discrepancies in timing and contents of the implemented actions.
